Elliot Berger, co-founded of USC Bag with US Cotton LLC opened their facility in 2005 in Albuquerque. Part of U.S. Cotton, USC Bag Manufacturing LLC., produces plastic bags for all of the private label cotton in retail stores such as CVS, Walgreens, Walmart, Target, etc... as well as many other FDA approved products such as tortillas, bread, potatoes, potting soil bags and promotional bags including “Run for the Zoo”. USC Bag produces 170 million plastic bags annually!

USC Bag’s current plant is 27,000 square feet and includes two Flexo-Graphic printing presses and a regenerative oxidizer to clean the air from the drying systems of the presses.

In addition to eight-color printing, USC Bag forms and heat seals bags and incorporates the zip seal we’ve all grown to love in daily lives.
