

We are pleased once again to share a presentation from one of our Chapter members. Although every company has one or more supply chains, they may not think of them in that way. They may think of them as a loose collection of manufacturing sites, warehouse, and distribution centers, managed as separate entities without realizing the full extent of the interconnectedness and interdependence, nor the benefits of a system-wide view.

In 2017-2018 W.L. Gore developed an optimization process using a higher level of Value Stream Mapping to analyze their supply chains as integrated end to end flows in 3-to-5-day workshops.

The workshop concept was piloted on supply chains in four Gore business units. In addition to reductions in supply chain lead time and increases in responsiveness, the combined financial benefit from these four workshops approached \$5 million annually. The workshops also reinforced the importance of some supply chain projects already in progress.

The supply chain mapping format, the workshop schedule, critical success factors, and some of the specific benefits will be described.

Topic: The Impact of AI & Data Science

Speaker: **Dr. Ben Amaba**



Technology and externalities are changing the dynamics of the supply chain, and the new systems are incorporating machine learning (ML), artificial intelligence (AI), data analytics, autonomous vehicles and robotic process automation. The convergence of these technologies holds great promise. This presentation describes the disruption in the supply chain and the primary patterns where ASCM professionals are taking an active role. The CPIM, CLTD, and CSCP lead in the domain process, governance, and foundation, rather than the algorithms and technology alone. Best practices in APICS/ASCM using CPIM, CLTD, CSCP, and SCOR provide a foundation where we can align measurable goals to the development of new machine learning or AI systems. The ability to connect the process, data, talent and trust will be vital as our supply chain profession advances for the future.

Dr. Ben Amaba's expertise is in executive management, strategic planning, operations, and engineering. Dr. Amaba is a registered and licensed Professional Engineer in several states with International Registry; certified in Production, Operations, and Inventory Management by APICS®; LEED® Accredited Professional (Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design); and certified in Corporate Strategy by Massachusetts Institute of Technology in Cambridge, Massachusetts. He is responsible for industrial manufacturing, infrastructure and logistics solutions. 

CPIM Certification


Acquire a working knowledge of the tools and techniques for planning of inventory, including planning techniques such as MRP, CRP, lean, TOC, and projects. Understand the effect of using each technique; know standard measurements for inventory, materials, capacity and supplier performance; and recognize when to escalate issues. Topics include:



- Managing inventory, planning material requirements, planning capacity requirements, and procurement and supplier planning
- Recognizing the importance of supply chain management and deploying supply chain strategies related to scheduling, planning, and sourcing
- Translating product-level plans and schedules generated at the master planning level into requirements that can be procured or produced
- Bridging the master planning area with the execution and control function
- Planning, scheduling, resource allocation, and implementing projects that are used to manage the supply of products and services 2017
